The acting officers and committee chairmen are:



Col. Brown was appointed to draw up a set of rules for operation of the local group.

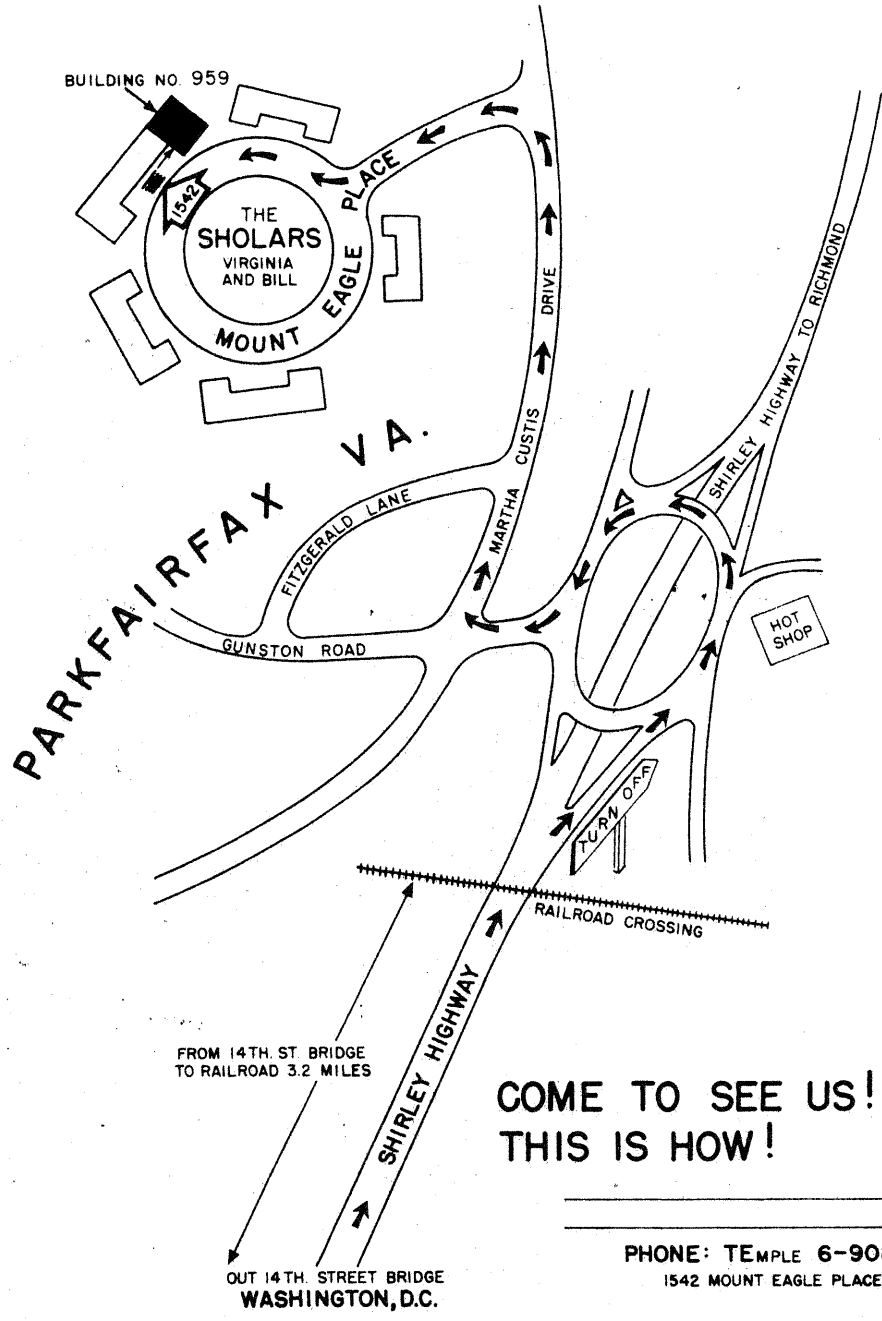
It was decided to charge \$5.00 for local dues. On January 1st this will be reconsidered.
