This signature program with the University of Maryland's Carey Law School uses a restorative justice framework to engage middle school students in educational activities that help them identify, question, and reject the destructive ideas that give rise to sexual violence.

#### Online sexual harassment training for youth serving adults.

Teacher Talk is a virtual training to help professionals identify and respond to sexual harassment. Because we know sexual harassment can be a precursor to sexual violence, we're providing resources so for intervention.

Sexual harassment happens. By giving educators the opportunity to learn how to respond to it, we're it less likely that sexual harassment escalates to sexual harm.

Parent Talk is an education campaign aimed at parents and caregivers.



Every Body Talk is an inclusive and trauma-informed children's book families can use to start conversations about keeping bodies safe. The book walks through language children and guardians can use to communicate about topics that can be tough.

The tiny bleachers allow you to get very close to the cars - you can practically see inside them. From the far left of the fence down low between the fence rails, car will seem as if they are coming right out of your photos.
н	Turn 5	Up the hill right next to the Turn 4 corner station.	Stand right next to the Turn 4 corner station. For photos, it's a very tight angle over the concrete barrier, but you can get some shots of the cars hanging on through the turn and also see cars coming over the hill from Turn 3.
1	Infield Grandstands	Unpaved adventure! Take the dirt & gravel road immediately in front of you as you cross the bridge going toward the paddock (green dotted line on map). Keep bearing right until out of the woods and in a field.	There are two Grandstands here; one straight ahead and one off to the left. To your right you will be able to see cars going up the hill. Straight ahead you will see cars transitioning from right to left hand turns. Up to your left you can see drivers trying to out-brake each other as they race into Turn 5.

## **How We Determine Who Gets the Trophies**

We have three sets of awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for the "Rock the Summit" PCA Club Race this weekend, one set each for Sprint Races (Green, Blue and Red Groups), Vintage Races (Silver Group), and Enduro Races.

**Sprint Races:** We award one set of sprint race trophies based on the combined results of the two Sprint races on Saturday. We combine the results as follows:

- Total the results of the two sprint races (1 point for first, 2 points for second, etc.)
- Lowest total receives first place, second lowest is second, etc.
- Ties are broken based on the lowest lap time in the two races. If identical, then we go to the second-best lap time, etc.
- Racers must finish both races to qualify for a trophy.

**Vintage Races:** We award one set of vintage race trophies based on the combined results of the three Vintage races, one on Friday and two on Saturday. Racers are awarded points in all 3 races based on finishing position in class. Two points are awarded for starting the race, and then 10 points for 1st, 7 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4 for 4<sup>th</sup>, 3 for 5<sup>th</sup>, 2 for 6<sup>th</sup> and 1 for 7<sup>th</sup> or higher. We award first, second and third place trophies to the highest points totals, in order. All podium finishers receive trophies regardless of the number of cars in the class.

**Enduro Races:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place stickers are awarded to those finishing positions in each class for its enduro race on Sunday.






## **PCA Potomac Club Race Event Safety Tips**

The safety of our racers, volunteers and guests is always our priority. Please take a moment to review these reminders.

- Do not block paddock roads with vehicles or equipment.
   Emergency vehicles must have open access to the entire paddock at all times.
- Obey the 10-mph paddock speed limit. Be responsible while using any motorized vehicle.
- Follow the posted clockwise directional flow of our paddock.
- Do not park non-essential vehicles in the paddock. Public parking is available past the paddock in the grass. Trailer parking is available over the bridge near Turn 10.
- The use of aerial drones is prohibited at Summit Point Motorsport Park and by PCA National.
- Consume alcoholic beverages only after all cars are off the track at the end of the day.
- The possession of illegal drugs or any firearms is strictly prohibited.
- Access is limited to in and around the main track. No access is permitted to other parts of the property.


